



Assessments in Your Journey as a Eufaula High School Student

Freshmen

***PSAT 8/9** will be given **February 20, 2019** to the Freshmen as a part of the A+ Grant and establishes a baseline for college readiness. It is aligned with the PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) and SAT. This test helps identify students who are likely to do well in an AP course.

*The date for this test is determined by the school within a window provided by PSAT.

Sophomores

Pre-ACT will be given on **October 17, 2018**. This is a state-mandated test and is given as an opportunity to take an ACT-like test in a less stressful environment and meant to be used as an instructional tool to impact the ACT Plus Writing Score (taken as Juniors) in a positive manner. It also connects to interests so that students can see if they are actually doing academically what is needed for them to accomplish the goals they have set for themselves.

Juniors

ACT Plus Writing, a college-entrance exam, will be given on **February 20, 2019**. This administration of the test is paid for by the state and is a free opportunity to gain a college entrance score and scholarship money. They have a make-up date on **April 24, 2019**. Students must benchmark in at least one area to be considered College and Career Ready – **English 18, Reading 22, Science 23, and Math 22**.

Seniors

ACT WorkKeys will be administered on **October 2, 2018**. This test was created by ACT with the contributions from businesses and community stakeholders about what they needed most in an incoming employee. Students can earn a certificate at bronze, **silver**, gold or platinum level. This certificate leads to potential employment. The City of Eufaula requires an ACT WorkKeys certificate for employment as do other local businesses and industries. Students must make a **silver** level to be considered College and Career Ready.
